#### **Investment Review: Revised Offers**

In December 2023, the Welsh Government announced our indicative settlement for 2024/25.

The reduced offer on our budget for 2024/25 was 10.5%. As a result we had to review all our costs across the organisation, including the multi-year funding offers. Council discussed the matter at its meeting on 2 February 2024 and agreed on a cut of 2.5% to be applied consistently to the initial offers made to the 81 successful applicant organisations in the report entitled <u>Investment Review 2023 Report and Decisions</u>.

The revised funding offers are detailed below.
