About this Award



We are the **Arts Council of Wales**.



We have an **award** called the **Eirian Llwyd Memorial Award**.

An **award** is money that people can get to help them do their work.



The **Eirian Llwyd Memorial Award** is money to help **printmaking** artists in Wales.



Printmaking is a type of artwork. Artists print their artwork onto paper, fabric, or other materials.



Galleries and Print Centres can pick artists who they think should get this **award**. And then apply for the **award** for them.

Who can apply



If you are a Gallery or Print Centre in Wales you can apply for this **award**.



You must have printmaking equipment that artists can use.



You can pick 2 artists who you think should get this **award**. But we can only choose 1 artist to help.



We would especially like to help **diverse** artists.

Diverse means people are not all the same. For example, people come from different backgrounds, make different choices, or are good at different things.



For example, we would like to help **printmaking** artists who have a disability.

Who this fund is for



This **award** is for artists who use **printmaking** to create their artwork.

The artist you pick must:



- Be Welsh or based in Wales. And they must want to stay and work in Wales.



- Be a **printmaking** artist.



- Be a really good artist. And be passionate about their work.

What we will pay for



We can give 1 **printmaking** artist up to £2500 each year.



This money should help the artist to carry on doing their work.

This money could be used to:



- rent a space to work in



- pay for advice from another artist



- buy equipment

What we need

You need to send us:



The name and email address of the artist you picked.



A written statement telling us why you picked this artist. Your statement should be no longer than 500 words.



The artist's CV and a written statement from them.



6-8 images of the artist's work.



If the artist's work is film or performance related, send us 5 minutes of their work.



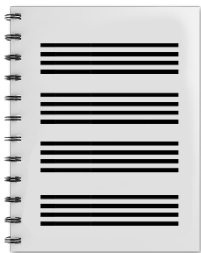
Make sure you send us any passwords we need to see their work.



You should send us all this information by email. It should be in 1 Word or PDF file.



The text should be no smaller than 12 point size.



The Word or PDF file should be no bigger than 250 MB.



We will look at everything you send us. Then we will decide who to give the **award** to.
